Who can join?

Disabled youths between the ages of 18 – 35. (subject to medical team review). As we have a restricted number of vacancies it will be based on a "first-come, first-served" basis. Each Guest needs to be accompanied by a caregiver of the same gender; if the Guest has no caregiver, we will provide one, wherever possible.

Who can volunteer?

We welcome youths between the ages of 18 – 35 eager to help us bring fun, laughter, and friendship to our disabled Guests. Volunteers will be subject to a selection criteria which will include a background check for security and suitability purposes.
